Dozens of homes received a fresh coat of paint (or two) and many families received electrical and plumbing updates, roof repairs, concrete repairs, home modifications and much more. All work was completed in a safe and timely manner. Thanks to all of our wonderful volunteers!

- **Summer means Neighbor • Care is in full swing!** - To date, 30 repairs have been completed through our year-round, county-wide program. The Christian Life Center volunteers will build 9 wheelchair ramps this summer. Ten homeowners will receive help from student and adult volunteers when the Catholic Heart Workcamp comes to town at the end of July. Holy Angels Summer of Service program is working Wednesdays in June and July on various exterior projects for homeowners throughout the area.
